Reimbursement:	65.2% (mandatory generic substitution)
Maximum annual contribution (after it's 100%):	\$1,066.00
Maximum annual contribution for persons age 65 or over (1% to 93% of GIS) :	\$632.00
Annual premium (payable on the income tax):	\$667.00 per adult
Annual premium for the year 2017: (This cost represents 6 months at \$660 and 6 months at \$667)	\$663.50 per adult
